FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Call to Order/Roll Call

Ms. Suit called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Ms. Suit stated Seats 1, 4 and 5 are up for election in 2024; two of the three seats are general election seats and one is a Landowner-elected seat with a four-year term. The General Election will be on November 5, 2024.

Ms. Whelan stated that Board Members whose seats will be up for election in the General Election and who are interested in remaining on the Board must qualify with the Supervisor of Elections (SOE) office in order for their name to appear on the ballot.
